Job Summary:

Performs a variety of tasks in laying, repairing, maintaining, and extending underground water and sewer mains and distribution/collection pipes.

Essential Functions:

- **1.** Regular and prompt attendance as scheduled.
- 2. Must be able to use and care for the tools, equipment, and materials used in assigned tasks, including sewer rodder, air compressor, jack hammer, and other related equipment.
- 3. Must be able to operate trucks, backhoes, trenchers, compressors and other machinery that is used.
- **4.** Must be able to break up pavement using air hammer and dig ditches in preparation for laying and/or removing pipe.
- 5. Must be able to maneuver pipe sections, valves, and fittings into position and hold pieces steady while co-worker tightens thread connections.
- 6. Must be able to cut, thread, join pipe sections and assist in caulking joints as directed.
- 7. Must be able to mix and lay concrete, lay brick, and finish concrete where moderately high degree of finish work is required on manholes.
- 8. Must be able to assist in the installation and removal of water meters.
- 9. May turn water services on and off.
- **10.** Must be able to assist in repairing leaks or breakage in water and sewer lines.
- **11.** Must be able to perform a variety of ground maintenance tasks (i.e., cut grass and weeds with hand tools and trim plants and shrubs.)
- **12.** Must be courteous and well-mannered at all times in dealing with the public.
- **13.** Must promptly report to the Supervisor any potential problem to the water or sewer system.
- **14.** Required to perform other duties as requested by supervisor.

Educational Requirements:

Must have high school diploma, GED or equivalent.

Job Requirements:

- 1. Must have physical strength and agility necessary to carry out heavy manual work; be able to lift 100 lbs. and frequently lift and carry objects weighing up to 50 lbs.
- 2. Must be able to receive, understand, and follow written and oral instructions.
- 3. Must be able to print and speak simple sentences.
- 4. Must be able to use all types of tools that might be required.
- 5. Must have and maintain a valid Class "B" Mississippi Driver's License.
- 6. Must be able to operate small and medium size trucks.
- 7. Must be able to add, subtract, multiply, and divide all units of measure.
- 8. Must be able to work outdoors in various weather conditions and temperature variations; occasionally under unfavorable weather conditions.
- 9. Must be able to stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl, reach, handle, finger, and feel objects.
- 10. Must be able to correctly erect barricades and safety lights around work site to protect co-workers from street traffic.
- 11. Often involved in strenuous work activities and exposed to normal hazards associated with traffic, excavation, machinery, tools, and other conditions connected with outside operational and construction activities.
- 12. Subject to overtime, stand-by time, and call-back during periods of time as needed.
